

Proclarity, Excel and Powerpoint were the tools most often used for manipulation and presentation of data. Business analysts were required to liaise not only with clients' research staff but regularly spoke with senior people in major corporations. Much of the work of collecting and collating good useful research was on an adhoc basis but also included specific projects designed with the client to determine new markets or investigate the likelihood of introducing products, consolidating product offerings or in the case of investment bankers, determining the viability of potential investments.
